

### MARKET COMMENTARY

The **DCI** had down tick of 0.01% to close the week at 7215.99 points, while the **FCI** remained flat to close the week at 1548.15 points. **BTCL** (+5 **thebe**), was the biggest gainer for the week to close at 74 thebe, while **Choppies** (-1 **thebe**), was the biggest loser for the week to close at 52 thebe.

The trading week activity led to a turnover amounting to BWP2,083,033 as 865,666 securities exchanged hands. Sefalana (20%) was the biggest contributor to the week's turnover.
