

### **MARKET COMMENTARY**

The **DCI** had yet another positive week, gaining 0.03% to close at 6585.56 points. The **FCI** went down by 0.01% to close at 1550.85 points. **ETF NewGold** (+450 thebe) was the biggest gainer of the week, closing at 18180 thebe while **CA Sales** (-4 thebe) was the sole loser for week, closing at 370 thebe.

The short trading week's turnover amounted to **BWP1,608,554** as **792,257** securities exchanged hands. **BIHL** (31%) and **BTCL** (26%) were the biggest contributors to turnover.

### **Primetime Trading Notice**

The Board of Directors of the Company brought to the attention of linked unitholders that the consolidated profit before tax for the six months ended 28 February 2021 is expected to be materially lower than the prior comparable period to 29 February 2020, by approximately 71% (P26.5m). Profits before tax in the prior period were P37m. Whilst the group's operating profits year on year are slightly down (by less than 3%), the primary reason for this decrease is the effect of period end foreign exchange conversions of intercompany loans which are denominated in USD. Originating from the recovery of the Pula during this period, these reflect losses of P19.5m in the current period vs profits of P7.5m in the prior period. Kindly note that these foreign exchange adjustments are unrealised and a non-distributable line item, and do not affect the distribution of profits to linked unitholders. The Company is expected to publish the interim financial results for the period ended 28 February 2021 by 31 May 2021. Accordingly, linked unitholders are advised to exercise caution when dealing in their securities.

### **CA Sales Additional Listing of Shares**

Shareholders are referred to the various announcements released on X-News and the 4AX website, as well as the circular dated 28 February 2020 advising that the Company had concluded an asset-for-share agreement ("Transaction Agreement") with Duncan Lewis ("Lewis") and Lewis's family trust, the Dunechanus Family Trust (together, the "Sellers"), in terms of which the Sellers will, between them, sell an aggregate of 203 ordinary shares held by them in the Company's subsidiary, Pack 'n Stack Investment Holdings Proprietary Limited ("Pack 'n Stack"), comprising 10.15% of the issued shares in Pack 'n Stack ("PnS Shares"), to CA Sales, the aggregate purchase consideration of which will be settled in two tranches by the Company issuing ordinary shares to the Sellers, such purchase consideration being capped at a maximum of ZAR 44 803 409 ("Transaction"). Shareholders are hereby advised that the second tranche of the Transaction has been concluded whereby CA&S will acquire 5.05% of Pack 'n Stack from the Sellers for an amount of ZAR 23 361 074.45. It will be settled by CA&S issuing 4 624 590 ordinary shares in aggregate to the Sellers, comprising approximately 1% of the total issued share capital in CA&S, on Wednesday, 12 May 2021. The total issued ordinary shares after the Transaction will be 456 831 459.
