

MARKET COMMENTARY

The DCI gained 0.11% to close the week at 8040.77 points. The FCI decreased by -0.01% to close the week at 1564.64 points. FNBB (+3 thebe), was the biggest gainer this week closing at 360 thebe, whilst BTCL (-2 thebe) was the biggest loser of the week closing at 78 thebe.

Market trading activity for the week led to a turnover amounting to BWP22,927,954 as 319,810 securities exchanged hands. NEWGOLD (98%) was the biggest contributor to the week's turnover.
