





# MARKET COMMENTARY

The DCI shed 0.27% to close the week at 6871.92 points on the back of losses from BTCL (-9 thebe), Sechaba (-30 thebe) and Chobe (-4 thebe) which closed at 60 thebe, 2080 thebe and 945 thebe respectively. The FCI remained flat at 1547.33 points. ETF New Gold gained 560 thebe to close at 20540 thebe, the security is the strongest performer year to date, up 38.9%.

Turnover for the week amounted to BWP13,560,579 off of 5,846,216 securities. Sechaba (44%) and FNBB (31%) were the biggest contributors to turnover.

### SeedCo restoration of full fungibility announcement

Following the migration of the secondary listing of Seed Co International Limited's shares from the Zimbabwe Stock Exchange ("ZSE") to the newly established hard currency denominated Offshore Financial Services Centre stock exchange, the Victoria Falls Stock Exchange ("VFEX"), shareholders and the investing public have been advised that on 05 November 2020 the Minister of Finance and Economic Development of the Republic of Zimbabwe restored fungibility of Seed Co International Limited's shares between the VFEX and the Botswana Stock Exchange ("BSE").

Accordingly, and subject to prevailing Exchange Control Regulations of Zimbabwe regarding fungibility, Seed Co International Limited shares are now freely transferrable for trading on either the BSE or the VFEX and transferability is allowed on either direction. The Minister of Finance and Economic Development of the Republic of Zimbabwe in his announcement lifted all fungibility restrictions on Seed Co International Limited shares with immediate effect.

Shareholders and the investing public who may wish to move their shares between the two exchanges, have been advised to consult their Stockbrokers, Custodians or the Company's Transfers Secretaries in Zimbabwe and Botswana.

Shareholders and the investing public have been reminded that the company is still trading under cautionary which was last renewed on 27 October 2020 regarding the proposed integration of the Zimbabwean operations, held through Seed Co Limited, under Seed Co International Limited. Accordingly, Shareholders have been advised to continue exercising caution when dealing in the Company's securities until further announcements regarding this proposed transaction that is going through regulatory approvals.
