

#### **MARKET COMMENTARY**

The DCI gained 0.31% to close the week at 8016.37 points. The FCI gained 0.02% to close the week at 1564.75 points. CA SALES (+15 thebe), was the biggest gainer this week closing at 520 thebe, whilst NEWGOLD (-680 thebe) was the biggest loser of the week closing at 24,120 thebe.

Market trading activity for the week led to a turnover amounting to BWP54,812,495 as 1,950,969 securities exchanged hands. NEWGOLD (85%) was the biggest contributor to the week's turnover followed by BIHL (7%).

#### NAP - Unaudited Group Financial Results for the Six Months Ended 31 January 2023

NAP has released its half year financial results. Among the highlights is an 8% increase in revenue to BWP119 million (HY 2022: BWP110 million). Net rental income increased 6% to BWP97 million (HY 2022: BWP92 million). Profit before tax decreased 10% to BWP72 million (HY 2022: BWP79 million). Earnings per linked unit decreased 18% to 11.94 thebe (HY 2022: 14.54 thebe). Distribution per linked unit of 15.11 thebe (HY2022: 14.26 thebe) comprises of debenture interest of 14.47 thebe and a dividend 0.64 thebe.

#### Turnstar - Audited Full Year Ended 31 January 2023 Results

Turnstar has released its half year financial results. Among the highlights is an 9% increase in rental income for the group to BWP291 million (HY 2022: BWP266 million). Profit before tax for the group decreased 2% to BWP112 million (HY 2022: BWP114 million). The balance sheet grew 4% to BWP2.66 billion (HY 2022: BWP2.55 billion). Diluted earnings per linked unit increased 5% to 19 thebe (HY 2022: 18 thebe). The group declared a final distribution per linked unit of 9 thebe which comprises of debenture interest of 7.3198 thebe and a dividend 1.6802 thebe.
